Plants are living things and they are very important because they give us food.



Plants are living things.



We eat different parts of a plant. We can eat the roots, leaves, stems or fruit.

For example, we eat leaves when we eat a lettuce, lettuce is a leaf. A carrot is a root, a leek is a stem and an apple is a fruit.

Lettuce is a leaf

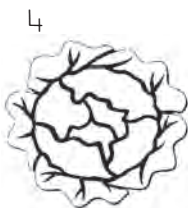

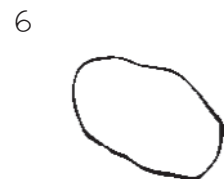

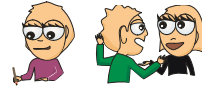


Plants produce oxygen

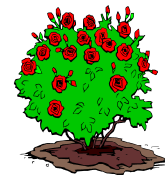

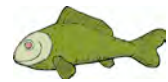

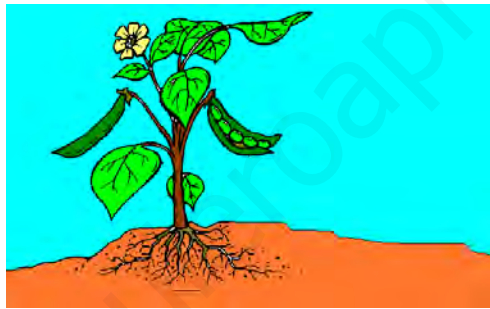

Parts of a plant.



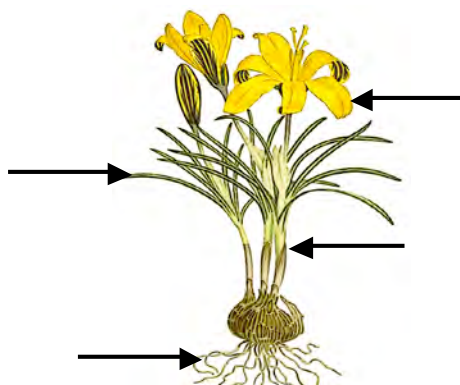
Plants have roots, a stem and leaves. They take in food from the roots and air through the leaves.
